Explanatory notes to Receipts and Payments Account:

- 1. Routes to Roots' application for Charitable Incorporated Organisation status was accepted by the Charity Commissioners on 26 February 2014. Routes to Roots (Poole) CIO was entered onto the Register of Charities with the Registered Charity Number 1155945. All funds, assets and liabilities were transferred from the old Charity No 1093689 to Routes to Roots (Poole) CIO during the year.
- 2. Grants in 2014/15 included £1,113 (restricted) from Dorset Police, towards the "Our Voice" Project, and £3000 from Spectrum Housing towards winter breakfasts and general client support. R2R also received £2000 from The Trelix Charitable Trust and £5000 from The Canford Cliffs Land Society, both towards general running costs.
- 3. R2R benefited from various fund raising events held during the year. We are very grateful to those who raised funds on our behalf.
- 4. No Gift Aid was received in 2014/15. Gift Aid of £2,464 is still to be reclaimed for years 2013-14 & 2014-15 (see B2 Other Monetary Assets).
- 5. The remainder of the restricted Winter Warmth fund £774 was spent in the year on breakfasts for our homeless and vunerable clients.
- 6. Spend on afternoon projects in the year included the remainder of the restricted Adult Social Services Grant (£1,655); the restricted grant received in the year from Dorset Police for the "Our Voice" Project was also fully spent (£1,113).
 7. This includes a one off set up cost of £500 for an Employee Pension Trust.

Independent examiner's report to the trustees of Routes to Roots (Poole) CIO

Respective responsibilities of trustees and examiner
